

Parent information and School Reminders

We would appreciate if parents, especially those new to the school, could take the time to read this section as there is some important information regarding our school. If you have any queries, please do contact the school office.

- Nut Policy Due to a severe nut allergy in school, we have a no nut policy. If you require further
 information, please see the school office.
- Leave of absence only in exceptional circumstances (such as a funeral) will leave be authorised. If
 you need to make a request for absence, please submit a request in writing giving full details as to why
 the absence must be taken during term time.
- Dogs are not allowed onto school property. This includes the area outside the front of school, the car
 park and the driveway.
- Please name all uniform and items brought to school. Any lost property brought to the school office will be returned frequently if it is named.
- Absence from school due to illness Reasons for absence may be offered verbally, by phone or left on school voicemail but must be followed by a letter on the child's return to school if the absence is for more than two days. Please contact the school no later than 9.30am on the first day of your child's absence.
- Arrival at School: Please can children be taken to the rear playground to line up before school. Please
 do not wait at the classroom doors (except Elm / Reception) as teachers will come to the rear
 playground to escort children into the classrooms. For children in Elm class; once the classroom doors
 are opened, please drop your children off and leave as quickly as possible to promote independence.
- Please be aware that school staff are not present in the playground until 8.45am. Please supervise
 young children until this time.
- There is no parking at school for parents. You are welcome to park at St Joseph's Church for drop off and collection times. If you are parking on local streets, please park responsibly as we do receive regular complaints regarding this.
- Please download the School Gateway app. Even if you do not need to make payments to the school, we would be grateful if you could register as it enables the school to send all text messages to you free, which we currently pay a fee for.
- School meal payments must be paid by start of school on Monday morning (or the first school day
 of the week). There are several ways you can make payments:
 - Via our online app school gateway, available at all times. We encourage all parents to book and pay for school meals this way even if your child receives free school meals
 - o Pay at the school office from 08.45 with cash
 - A clearly marked envelope handed to breakfast club staff with cash
 - o A clearly marked envelope for your child to hand in to the school office with cash

Kidz Care Club Payments

Please book your Kidz Care Club and Breakfast Club sessions via the school gateway app. You can do this if you pay via bank transfer, childcare vouchers or cash.

For School Gateway App – Choose the club you would like to use and select the chosen dates. You can book as far in advance as you like but you must pay at the time of booking. You must make the first gateway payment via a computer to register your card details. If you do not have access to a computer at home, please see the school office.

For Childcare Vouchers – Please send the payment with your child's name and BC or KCC as the reference. If you would like the voucher split between more than one club then please email the office your preference. Once the payment has been received, it will be credited to your school gateway account. You will then be able to book the sessions you require. Please send the childcare vouchers in enough time for them to be processed before your required session.

For Cash – Please bring the correct money in an envelope marked with your child's name followed by BC or KCC and the date. The money can then be credited to your school gateway account where you will be able to book the required sessions.

If your child was born on or between **1 September 2015** and **31 August 2016**, you need to apply for a primary school place now.

You must still apply even if your child already attends a nursery attached to the school.

Deadline for applications is 15 January 2020.
